
PICKLED SANTA






Pickled Santa is a copper coloured ale.

The base beer is simple but very traditionally English, brewed with Maris Otter malted barley and 100% whole Golding hops. A hint of the unusual side of Pickled Santa lies in the name because it is brewed with a selection of whole spices. Yes... fresh whole spices! Not flavour extracts, not essential oils, and not ready ground supermarket blends.

The result is intriguing. Pickled Santa is fuller, softer and rounder than you would expect a 6% ale to be. That's not altogether surprising because in Victorian England before the days of analytical chemistry we brewers used to regularly add Coriander to beer for it's power to make the beer seem stronger and "bigger" than it would otherwise be. But you don't really taste or smell the Coriander.
