
## REINDEER'S REVOLT

Brakspear's master brewer, Peter Scholey, was determined to strike out on his own. He started Ridgeway Brewing, not far from Henley and has been putting out fantastic beers ever since.

Reindeer's Revolt is a golden-amber, hop accented, English "winter warmer" brewed without spices. It's lighter on the palate than the other Ridgeway holiday beers.

If you're looking for something to drink to escape the drudgery of the holiday season, this would be the beer for you. Perfect for relaxing on the beach with a coconut in one hoof, and a beer in the other.
