

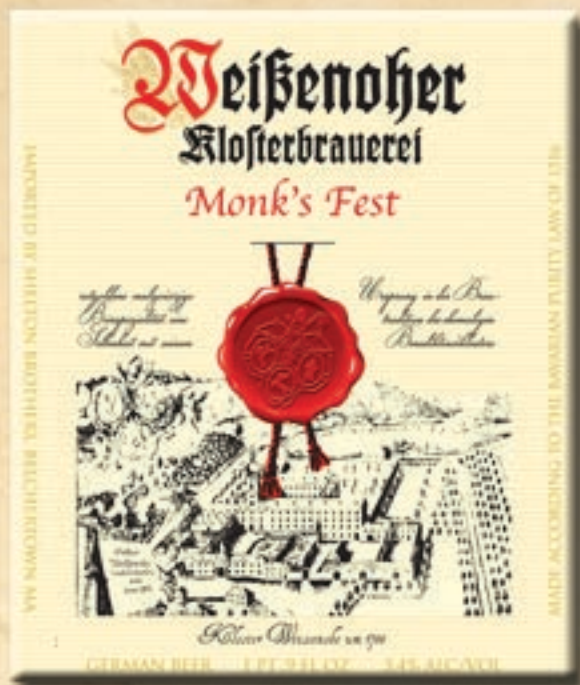
# MONK'S FEST

German Märzen beer - hearty, amber-colored, malty, and finely balanced lager that is refreshing and filling all at once - was the original staple of Oktoberfest celebrations. The Monk's Fest comes to us from the beautiful monastery at Weissenhohe, in the green wooded hills of Franconia, northern Bavaria. This rare, traditional, and very tasty 'liquid bread', is as close as you can get to the real thing.

At Weissenhohe, the Reinheitsgebot (the Bavarian beer purity law) is still observed by owner Urban Winkler. His beer is made by the traditional, and painstaking, double-decoction method, passed down to him by earlier generations of brewmasters at Weissenhohe and rarely observed in Bavaria today.
